Marvin Glover – Follow The Line:

Single/Video Release:

After a terrific debut in the Northwest with his first single, "Changes," Marvin Glover will release his second track, "Follow The Line," to regional radio stations on April 25th, 2006. The video, produced by Brian Quist and TJ Martin of Global Griot, will be available on the internet at myspace.com, Sonicbids and marvinglover.com

Taken from his latest album, *MUSE*, "Follow The Line" presents an optimistic, positive message characteristic of Glover's trademark songwriting style. Reflecting on the meaning behind the lyrics ("*Take a chance/What's to lose? If you fail you will bruise. Pick yourself up/Don't explain/You've got skills press on again.*") Marvin explains, "This song has always been one of my favorites. "I often see people trying to assimilate to what was is going on and how temptation affects their lives. There are no shortcuts, sometimes you just have to follow the line and stay on course, because if you try to deviate you are going to get screwed. It's just a melding of influences - a mixed bag of pop happiness."

The video was filmed on location in San Diego California's beautiful Balboa Park, using the historic early 1900's Spanish Colonial architecture and botanical gardens to set the scene. Marvin worked with The Global Griot film crew to develop a storyline, showing energy while not entirely focusing on just the performance of the song. Balboa Park's spectacular Organ Pavilion served the video well as an excellent backdrop.

MUSE is a concept album featuring twelve original songs offering pop rock, reggae, funky grooves and soulful vocal commentary attracting listeners of all musical tastes and generations. The CD was selected as the "Editor's Pick" on CDBaby.com and debuted at number four in the new release entries. "All the songs on *MUSE*, are written about my experiences, and the Muses that guided me through the process," Glover explains, "I aim to be honest with my writing. I want to present an honest positive vibe."
